## **Individual Student Requirements**

- White/cream fabric. Cotton, silk or wool. Some large, some smaller. This can be woven or knit. Think samples. Experimentation.
- Sticks or dowel x 6 or more (about 6 to 8 inches long x 1-3cm diam)
- Resist blocks in pairs/ Clamps / rubber bands
- Strong string, warp thread is good. or kevlar kite line
- Normal cotton, needles / pins
- Silk or cotton thread (to dye for stitching embellishment) variety.
- old towel
- plastic jug 1 litre
- Paper and pencil, camera.
- Sharp scissors
- Bead, button or shells to identify your work.
- Metal (iron or steel) scraps (nails, pieces etc)
